ASIA & AUSTRALASIA

Hutchison Ports has its heaviest concentration of terminals in Asia and Australasia. These have developed over the years in tune with shifting manufacturing bases and growing infrastructure.

From the trade arteries of Northeast Asia to the Special Economic Zones of China and the industrial heartlands of Southeast Asia. We have deployed some of the most advanced terminal equipment in the region to meet increasing mega-vessels calling our deep-water berths terminals. The group's first Regional Operations Centre, mixed mode Autonomous Truck operations and AI technology development are all introduced in the same region offering greater flexibility to customers, provide eco-friendly business environment and energy saving solutions.

Hutchison Ports has some of the most extensive mega-vessel handling facilities with remote-control and automated equipment supported by the latest technology and capable of handling multiple mega-vessels simultaneously setting a benchmark in its category.

MIDDLE EAST & AFRICA

Hutchison Ports is strategically located in a number of growing and emerging markets in the Middle East and Africa. We have made significant contributions and investments to the development of the ports we operate. Our growing network in the region facilitates both local and international trade to the countries in which we operate and expand their industrial bases.

With an increase demand of cold chain facilities, Hutchison Ports' terminals offer automated temperature-controlled facilities with extensive warehouse logistics connections and utilises green energy where possible to ensure a sustainable operations.

The group will continue to collaborate with local developer to develop, operate and explore new business opportunities to expand the group's portfolio.

EUROPE

Hutchison Ports has a significant presence in Europe where it operates some of its most environmentally friendly and technologically advanced container terminals, including the group's first semi-automated terminal.

These large-scale terminal facilities that are bolstered by a network of inland feeder terminals and connections to ports spread across Europe and North Africa. The favourable geographical location of its many deep-water terminals is supplemented by end-to-end value-added services and the expansion of facilities capable of handling all variety of cargo.

Our ports are located in the heartlands of Europe's rapidly growing distribution regions and leading industrial centres lies an extended network of multimodal feeder hubs. It offers a wide range of connections to the seaports and our inland terminals via an extensive intermodal transport network spanning the rest of Europe.

THE AMERICAS

Hutchison Ports' portfolio in the Americas has its highest concentration of terminals in Mexico where it offers a wide-range of services and diverse operations handling a variety of cargo and vessel types. The country's attractiveness as a manufacturing destination, with proximity to the US market serves as a gateway to the Pacific Coast of the US and Mexico as well as Central and South America.

Our Americas network also includes a number of ports serving as a transshipment hub in Panama, located at both ends of the Panama Canal in Balboa and Cristobal serving along the transatlantic and transpacific routes. A deep-water container port in the Bahamas, Freeport, connecting the eastern seaboard of the US and the principal east/west line trade lanes throughout the region.

We will continue to invest in advanced technological facilities equipped with automated green solutions leading to a sustainable and efficient operation to the Latin America and the Caribbean.



SMART PORT STRATEGY

Hutchison Ports set the standard for technological advancement to port operations and has roll out many inventive terminal developments and projects throughout its network of ports. These cutting-edge developments have resulted in improved cost efficiency, increased productivity and reduced downtime. 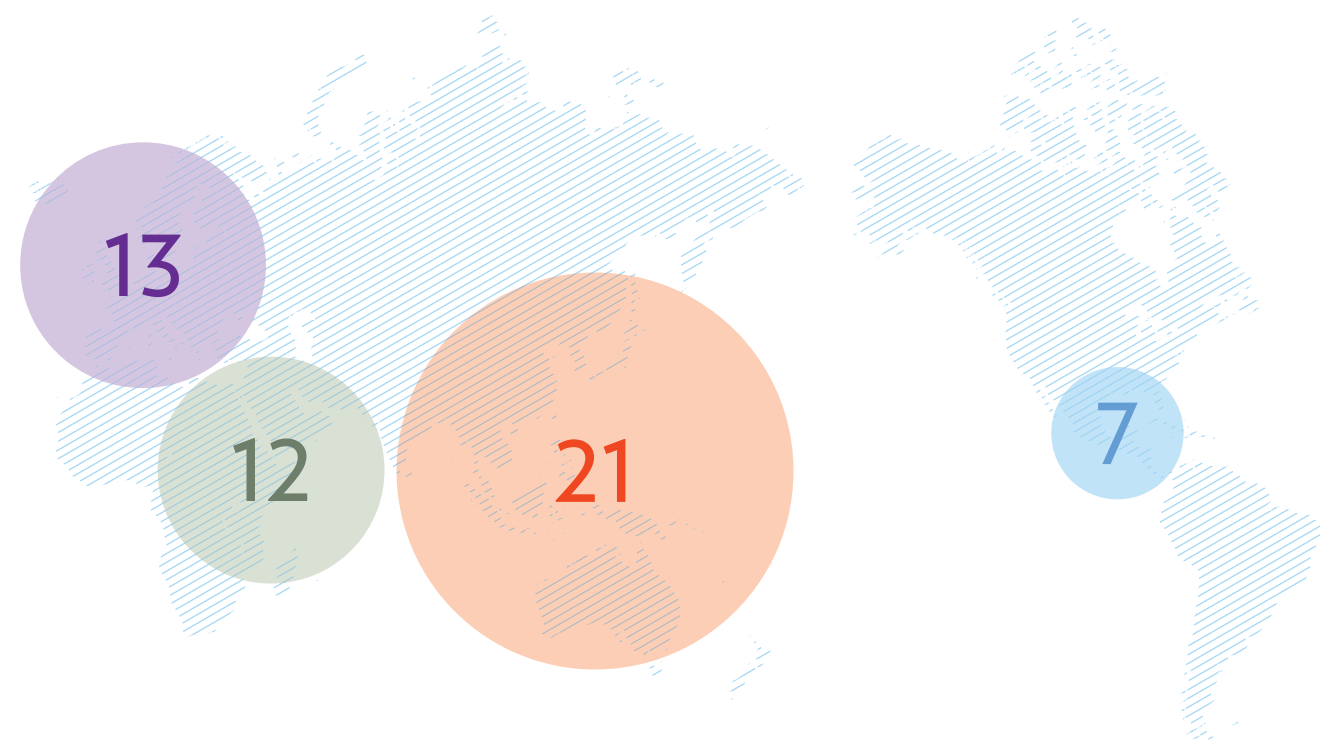
